



## CULINARY ESCAPE FROM YANGON

4 days / 3 nights

### D1 YANGON: ARRIVAL AND DINNER DISCOVERY OF ETHNIC SPECIALTIES (D)

Upon arrival, welcome by the local guide at Yangon airport, transfer and check-in at the hotel.

Note: Rooms are available from 2pm.

A short orientation tour is arranged to have a glimpse of the unique charm of the capital. Walk in the colonial area to discover its ancient buildings: the old post office, the famous Strand hotel and Yangon's harbour.



In the evening, transfer to "Tha In Thar" restaurant to taste a medley of ethnic dishes from around the country. Myanmar is rich with more than 130 ethnic minorities each having some culinary specialties.

### D2 YANGON: INDIAN COOKING CLASS

(B/L)

After breakfast, transfer to Kali's temple gate. The morning starts with a stroll through Theingyi Market to buy food and spices. This is also an opportunity to observe the supply centre of the large Indian community in Yangon and watch the craftsmen at work.

During the walk, visit:

- A Masala Workshop to learn how the Indian Masala is made
- A Butter Shop to learn how Indian Oil, Yogurt and Margarine is made
- A 60 year old Indian Shop that sell all kinds of flours, beans and many products directly imported from India
- Roadside Vegetable Market
- The Main Market with a wide variety of products on display, including spices

Participants head together to Beena’s kitchen for refreshment drinks with a fantastic view of Shwe Dagon Pagoda and prepare a complete meal with starter, soup or salad, vegetable curry, Indian bread and dessert.

Around noon enjoy the meal prepared during the class together. Return to hotel and afternoon is free at leisure.

### D3 YANGON: MOHINGA & GOURMET DINNER (B/L/D)

After breakfast, depart for a day exploring the former capital.

Stroll through Kandawgyi Park with its picturesque wooden boardwalks crossing the lake. Then visit the National Museum (closed on Mondays and holidays), with a collection of precious artefacts tracing the country’s history.

By midday, transfer to “Yangon Tea House”. This is an opportunity to enjoy a typical Mohinga in a warm atmosphere in the typical tea shop style that can be found in the streets of the city.

In the afternoon, visit Chauk Htet Gyi Pagoda, Sule Pagoda and the Chinese and Indian districts. Then visit the majestic Shwedagon Pagoda, with its golden dome dominating the skyline of the city.

Later on, transfer to “Le Planteur” restaurant, one of the best tables in Asia. The chef proposes a gourmet cuisine blending Asian and Western most famous dishes.

Overnight in Yangon.

After breakfast, time is free at leisure at the hotel.
